Dear Tres Islas Orphanage Fund Donors,

On behalf of the girls who reside in FloreSer, our board of directors and caregivers, we are grateful to write to you again this year to thank you for continuing to believe in our mission and helping our girls.

Each year, this is a special letter we write as we thank you for each of the contributions you made to the girls and their home for the past year. We are proud, as well as grateful, to have you share in helping us give these girls a new life full of promise and good opportunities. This year we thank you for:

- \$124.00 U.S. dollars' worth of groceries each week (\$6,446.06 U.S. dollars for the year), providing them quality, fresh food each day.
- Purchasing their school supplies, shoes, uniforms, backpacks, school books and paying for their classes: \$1,692.89 U.S. dollars – an opportunity that we've shared with you before, that for many, is the first time they've been able to receive an education.
- A delicious Christmas dinner with all of the trimmings including presents for each of the girls: \$120.11 U.S. dollars plus Christmas presents of needed pajamas and undergarments: \$371.66 U.S. dollars.
- Construction improvements on the girls home: \$7,299.48 U.S. dollars.
- Completing work on the girls' reconciliation room, (the room where they receive counseling, learn how to forgive and work through their previous abuse): including, tables, chairs, projector sound system, tiling the floors and paint: \$3,412.17 U.S. dollars.
- Paying for necessary repairs and fixtures in four bathrooms: \$1,856.67 U.S. dollars
- Purchasing plates, silverware and blankets: \$107.07 U.S. dollars.
- Purchasing photo paper and ink and computer paper
- Purchasing the items needed and stocking the receiving room with school supplies, personal hygiene, sundry and medical supplies. Having everything organized and on-hand daily makes all of our lives much more convenient and shows the girls how to properly organize a home: \$346.41 U.S. dollars.
- Medical needs, including purchasing the girls medicine, doctor visits and tests: \$469.88
- The annual beach barbecue party during the Spring Mission Trip for the children in all the orphanages. Our girls enjoyed the day with all of you at the beach, the delicious food and meeting the other youngsters.

The above needs – that are paramount to the girls, their well-being, their daily lives, health and future – wouldn't be possible without each and every one of you generous Tres Islas donors. On behalf of the girls, board of directors and caregivers, we thank you for all you do to support and improve the lives of the girls each and every day. We ask, please, for your continued support through the Tres Islas Orphanage Fund so these girls, and those who will follow, may learn to lead a life of dignity – thanks in large part – to each and all of you.

We hope to see you all during Spring Mission Week 2014 – April 25th through May 3rd!
